


### MISSION - Provide

### **Strategic Readiness Direcorate**

Mission: Ensures the delivery of medical logistic support to the Combatant Commands in support of exercises, competition and crisis

Integrates geographically aligned desk officers and analysts to oversee the readiness of mission critical centralized programs in support of the warfighter. Synchronizes the support of nine globally dispersed Army Prepositioned Stock, contingency programs, and unit deployment readiness across the five continents, while nesting AMLC's strategic-level posture within multiple campaign and contingency plans.

### **Materiel Readiness Directorate**

Mission: Provides consistent evaluation of the Army's Centralized and Contingency Programs Medical Materiel Readiness through data analysis and quality assurance assessments for the deployment capability.

Coordinates, synchronizes and projects readiness of strategic level CL VIII materiel, medical equipment maintenance, optical fabrication and logistical support for exercises and real-world missions through various capabilities such as Army Pre-positioned Stocks (APS), Medical Materiel Readiness Program (MMRP), Unit Deployment Packages (UDP) Programs and Theatre Lead Army Medical Materiel (TLAMM) centers Europe and Korea.
