He then went on to be a Forward Medical Observer/Trainer/Coach, Fort Irwin, CA; a Chief Instructor Writer, Joint Base San Antonio, San Antonio, TX; an AIT First Sergeant at CO F 232nd Cadre, JBASA, San Antonio, TX; a Chief Clinical NCO at Walter Reed Medical Center, Bethesda, MD; a Chief Medical NCO for Eighth Army Surgeon Directorate, Camp Humphrey, Korea; and the Battalion Command Sergeant Major for the Headquarters and Headquarters Battalion, Eighth Army, Camp Humphrey, Korea.
