MAJ Shirley Rivera is a native of El Salvador and moved to Novato California at the age of 12. She enlisted in 2006 as a U.S. Army 92Y, Supply Specialist. She completed Basic Training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina, and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Gregg-Adams, Virginia. While enlisted, CPT Rivera deployed to Iraq with 4th Infantry Division and to Afghanistan with 82nd Airborne Division. In 2012 she was selected for the Army ROTC Green to Gold Hip Pocket Scholarship.

MAJ Rivera is a Distinguished Military Graduate of Campbell University, North Carolina (Summa Cum Laude) and commissioned into the Medical Service Corps in 2015. She holds a Master of Business Administration with a focus in Supply Chain Management from the University of Maryland Smith School of Business.

MAJ Rivera's most recent assignment to USAMMDA's Program Management Acquisition Internship Program (PMAIP) culminated with the successful achievement of her 8X identifier.
