U.S. ARMY MEDICAL LOGISTICS COMMAND (AMLC) is the Army's primary medical logistics and sustainment command, responsible for managing the global supply chain and medical materiel readiness across the Total Force.

AMLC's subordinate commands include:



U.S. Army Medical Materiel Agency (USAMMA)

Delivers medical materiel readiness, synchronizing and integrating strategic sustainment, supply support and maintenance capabilities to enable global health care operations.

U.S. Army Medical Materiel Center - Europe (USAMMC-E)

Plans, synchronizes and provides medical logistics support to the warfighter and their families in U.S. European Command, U.S. Central Command, U.S. Africa Command, and U.S. Department of State across the full range of military operations.

U.S. Army Medical Materiel Center - Korea (USAMMC-K)

Provides comprehensive medical logistics support to United States Forces Korea in order to set and sustain readiness and multi-domain operations.
