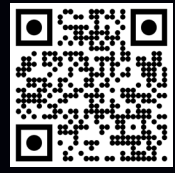

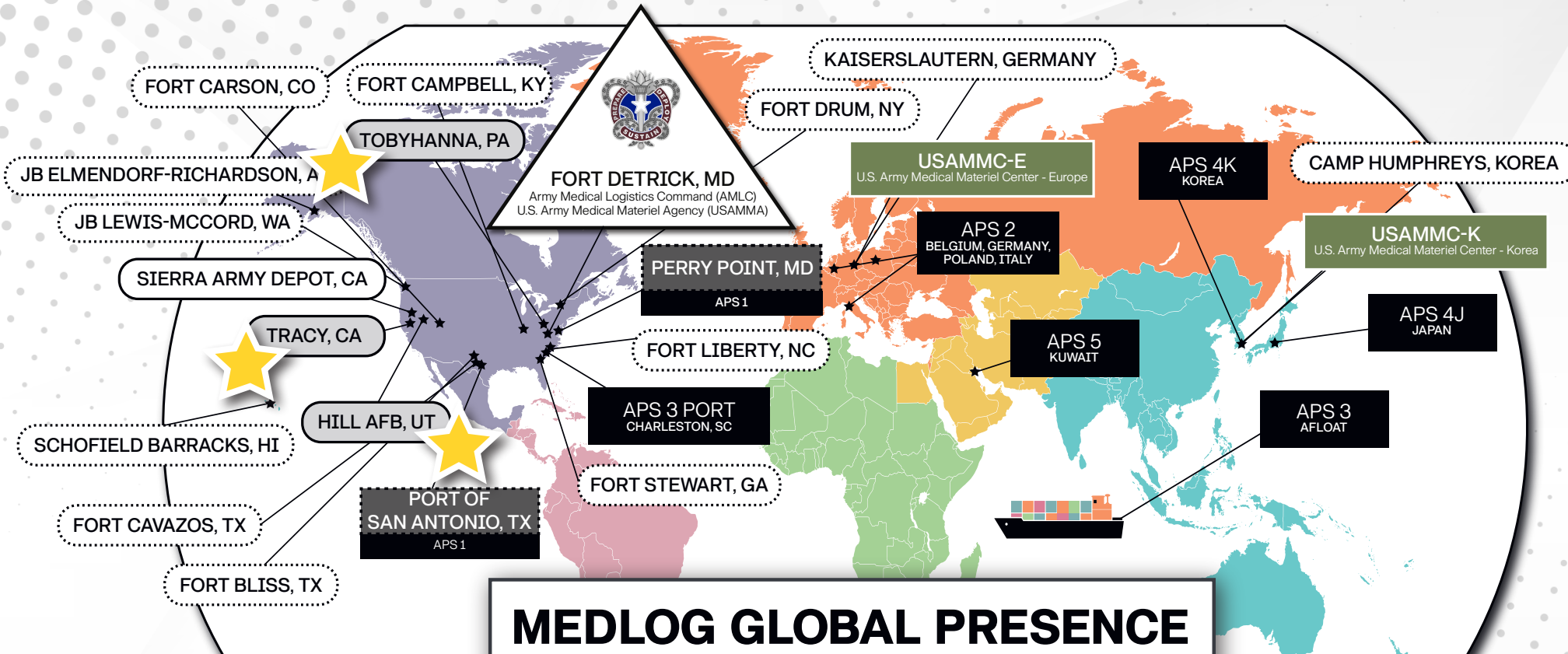
## CAPABILITIES

- Sustainment-level medical maintenance operations
- Medical maintenance for centrally managed programs and expert-level repair support in operational environments
- Recapitalize medical equipment
- Calibrate special purpose Test, Measurement, and Diagnostic Equipment
- Manage contingency programs, such as Medical Materiel Readiness Program (MMRP)
- Sustain and issue medical Army Prepositioned Stock (APS)
- Vaccine distribution
- Cold Chain Management training
- Technical business support and record system training
- Manage and update the medical materiel catalogue
- Medical Foreign Military Sales (FMS)

# U.S. ARMY MEDICAL MATERIEL AGENCY (USAMMA)



USAMMA operates three stateside Medical Maintenance Operations Divisions (MMODs) that execute sustainment-level maintenance for their regions and serve as a Centers of Technical Excellence:

## MMOD - UT

Hill Air Force Base, UT  
Pulmonary equipment, anesthesia equipment, and oxygen concentrating equipment

## MMOD - CA

Defense Distribution Depot Tracy, CA  
Medical imaging equipment, and Special Purpose Test, Measurement & Diagnostic Equipment (SP-TMDE)

## MMOD - PA

Tobyhanna Army Depot, PA  
Clinical (field) lab equipment

USAMMA provides medical logistics support for several Department of Army readiness programs to include acquisition, storage, distribution and transfer of prepositioned stocks located ashore and afloat, as well as medical chemical defense packages and short shelf life pharmaceuticals and other materiel. As part of the force projection strategy, these programs contribute to the Army's ability to rapidly deploy decisive power worldwide.

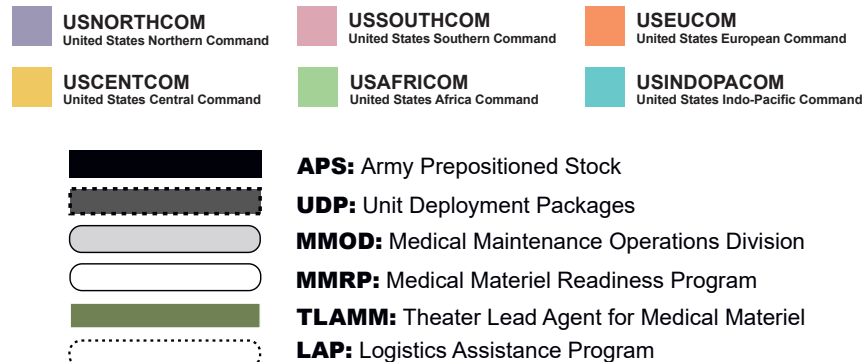
