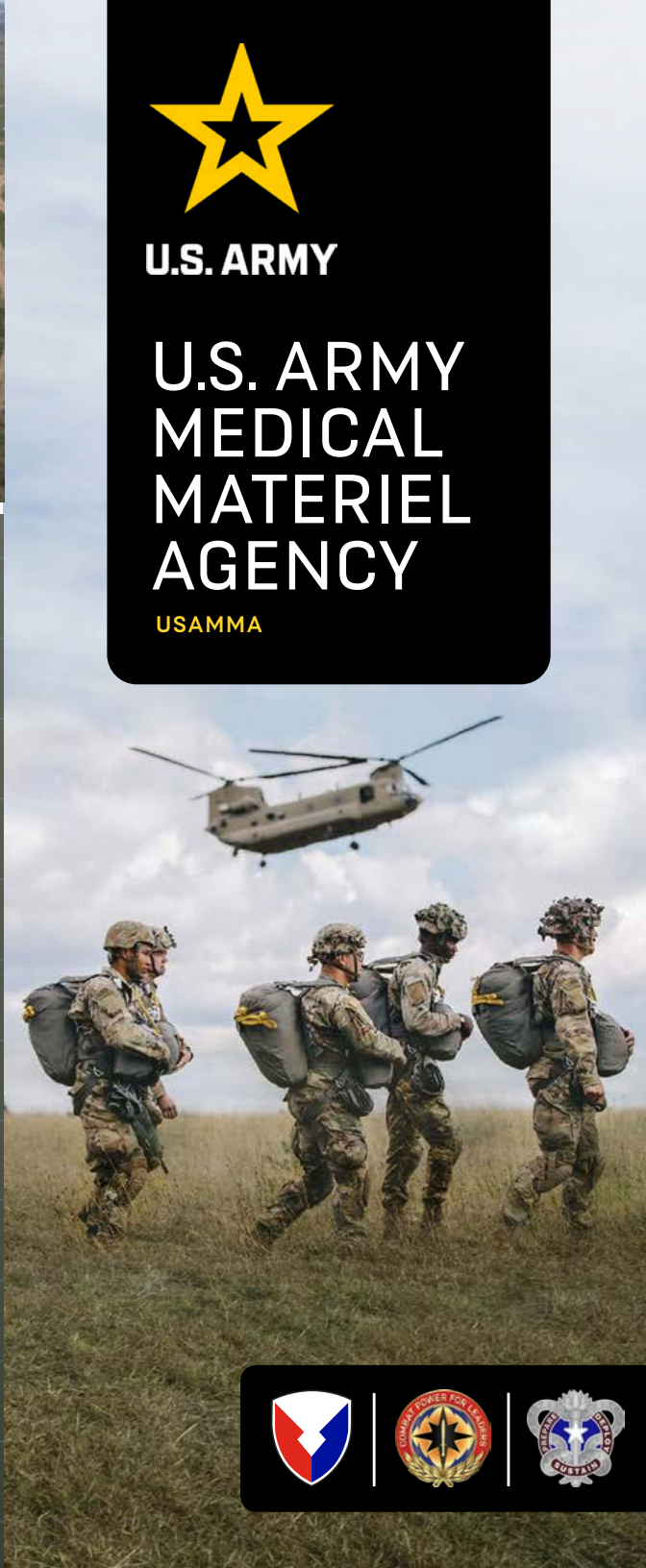

- AGENCY ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:**
- Provides sustainment-level medical maintenance operations
 - Supports medical maintenance for National Guard units, centrally managed programs, and expert-level repair support in operational environments
 - Recapitalizes medical equipment
 - Calibrates special purpose Test, Measurement, and Diagnostic Equipment
 - Manages contingency programs, such as Medical Materiel Readiness Program (MMRP)
 - Sustains and issues medical Army Prepositioned Stock (APS)
 - Distributes vaccines
 - Provides Cold Chain Management training
 - Provides technical business support and record system training
 - Manages and updates the medical materiel catalogue
 - Facilitates medical Foreign Military Sales (FMS)



U.S. ARMY MEDICAL MATERIEL AGENCY (USAMMA)

USAMMA delivers medical materiel readiness, synchronizing and integrating strategic sustainment, supply support and maintenance capabilities to enable global health care operations.

USAMMA operates three stateside Medical Maintenance Operations Divisions (MMODs) that execute sustainment-level maintenance for their regions and serves as a Center of Excellence:

MMOD - Hill

Hill Air Force Base, UT

Pulmonary equipment, anesthesia equipment, and oxygen concentrating equipment

MMOD - Tracy

Defense Distribution Depot San Joaquin, CA

Medical imaging equipment, and Special Purpose Test, Measurement & Diagnostic Equipment (TMDE)

MMOD - Tobyhanna

Tobyhanna Army Depot, PA

Clinical (field) lab equipment

The highest trained equipment experts from each MMOD also rotationally deploy as part of a team called the Forward Repair Activity-Medical (FRA-M). The FRA-M travels around the globe to provide expert-level training and support to unit-level biomedical equipment specialists.

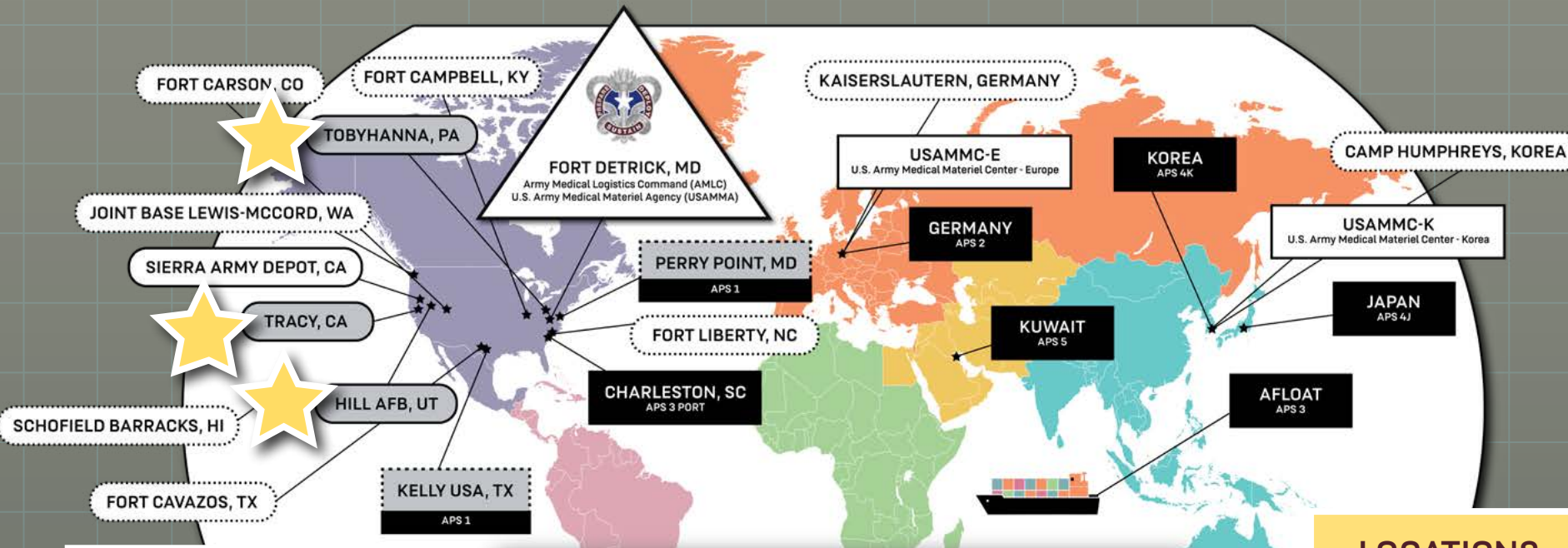
Additionally, USAMMA provides medical logistics support for several Department of Army and Office of The Surgeon General (OTSG) readiness programs. The programs include acquisition, storage, distribution and transfer of prepositioned stocks located ashore and afloat, as well as medical chemical defense packages and short shelf life pharmaceuticals and other materiel. As part of the force projection strategy, these programs contribute to the Army's ability to rapidly deploy decisive power worldwide.

Army Prepositioned Stock (APS):

- Brigade / Unit Sets
- Operational Projects
- War Reserve Sustainment

Contingency Stock:

- Medical Chemical Defense Materiel (MCDM)
- Centrally Managed Medical Potency and Dated Materiel Program (Unit Deployment Packages, or "UDPs")
- Medical Materiel Readiness Program (MMRP)
