

Mission Execution

USAMMC-E is an Army medical materiel center subordinate to the U.S. Army Medical Logistics Command. USAMMC-E provides theater-level acquisition, storage, and distribution of medical materiel, optical fabrication, and medical equipment maintenance.

USAMMC-E is designated as the Theater Lead Agent for Medical Materiel (TLAMM) for U.S. European Command (EUCOM) and U.S. Africa Command (AFRICOM). USAMMC-E also provides medical materiel support for U.S. Central Command (CENTCOM), which covers operations from northeastern Africa to south-western and south central Asia.

USAMMC-E maintains a warehouse inventory of more than 4,500 items and a catalog of more than 45,000 items. In recent years, USAMMC-E has received annual requests for Class VIII materiel valued up to \$150 million.

USAMMC-E typically fabricates more than 48,000 optical pieces per year and receives more than 4,000 orders for medical equipment maintenance annually.

USAMMC-E also develops business improvements to better serve the needs of customers, such as advanced information management and logistics systems for medical materiel supply chain management and medical product requisitions.

Working in collaboration with the 21st Theater Sustainment Command, USAMMC-E supports nearly 650 Army, Navy, Air Force, and Department of State hospitals, clinics, embassies, and field units.

The USAMMC-E team includes nearly 300 experienced and highly skilled personnel, including military, civilians, contractors and local nationals.
