Vaccine Ordering Portal / MMQC applications migration to a new platform.

Reason / Information:

US Army Medical Materiel Agency Distribution Operations Center (USAMMA DOC) is providing guidance with regards to the Army Medical Logistics Command (AMLC) migration to a cloud-based environment. Reason: AMLC will migrate its web tool, Medical Materiel Information Portal (MMIP), into a cloud-based environment. This process will cause the vaccine ordering and MMQC portal to be inoperable for a temporary time period.

Disposition / Instructions:

BACKGROUND:

The USAMMA DOC vaccine ordering portal and the Medical Materiel Quality Control (MMQC) are embedded within the Medical Materiel Information Portal (MMIP). MMIP integrates materiel catalog search and Army Unit Assemblage (UA) search tools formerly known as MEDSILS. MMIP also provides units with access to medical materiel literature, equipment start-up and accessory lists, and UA handbooks for current as well as archived medical Sets, Kits, and Outfits, or SKOs. Additionally, MMIP supports distribution and searching of Medical Materiel Quality Control (MMQC) and Army-Medical Materiel Instructions, utilized by logisticians, supply managers, and/or pharmacists to assure the proper suspension of use, handling, and return of recalled materiel.

AMLC in its efforts to improve medical logistics readiness and refine its business processes to align with the Army sustainment community, AMLC continues to migrate its web tools into a cloud-based environment. The Legacy AMEDD server that houses the Medical Materiel Information Portal (MMIP), and MMQC portal, will sunset no later than May 26, 2023. The

USAMMA's Vaccine Ordering Portal will not be available starting on 18 May 2023.

ACTIONS NEEDED:

1) Medical Treatment Facilities (MTFs) and supported customers will be able to continue to order Anthrax, ACAM2000, Jynneos and COVID-19 vaccination. USAMMA DOC will have ordering forms that will be posted on our USAMMA DOC sharepoint site at <https://cecom.aep.army.mil/sites/usamma/doc/SitePages/Vaccine%20Ordering.aspx> (CAC is required).

--- Customers will complete the order form and email them to usarmy.detrick.usamma.mbx.vaccines@army.mil

--- Allow 10 business processing days

--- Orders needed within 5 business days or less customers will need to call their service rep or call USAMMA DOC. (See below the point of contact information)

2) Medical Materiel Quality Control (MMQC)

--- MTFs DMLSS USERS will continue to receive ECRI Hazard Alerts and Recalls (HAR) notifications via DMLSS.

--- Operational forces should visit the following site to view messages: <https://cecom.aep.army.mil/sites/usamma/doc/default.aspx> (CAC is required).

--- USAMMA DOC will continue to create clinical messages as needed and post on the SharePoint site for all customers to view and retrieve.

--- USAMMA DOC will have available 1 year of archived vaccine clinical MMQC's for reference.

--- USAMMA DOC will post all Class I messages on the SharePoint site.
